Fire exits blocked	Preventing swift and easy exit from the building	High	Remove all items in front of fire exits	Low
Personal items	Risk of personal items belonging to the team being misplaced or stolen	Medium	Store personal possessions of the team on duty in the lounge	Low
Public entering the building during the event	Children coming into contact with adults they don't know	Medium	Parents/carers responsibility to watch where their children are and who they are talking to	Low

Burns and scalds	Adults and children come into contact with hot items in the kitchen	High	No one under the age of 16 to enter the kitchen during the hours of 9 and 12 noon when Mustard Seed is running	Low
Allergies	Children or adults coming into contact with identified allergy items	High	Avoiding serving biscuits with nuts.	Low
