Tearfund is a well-established & recognised Christian charity working with local churches in more than 50 countries, including those currently affected by war and those suffering the effects of climate change & plastic pollution. They tackle poverty & injustice by empowering communities to bring about change themselves by sustainable development.

Mission — To follow Jesus where the need is greatest, responding to crises and partnering with local churches to help communities lift themselves out of poverty.

Vision — To see people freed from poverty, living transformed lives in Jesus, and fulfilling their God-given potential.
